Signature Page for SAP® DMS



What is Signature Page?

A signature page is a file with one or more pages containing status and release information about a document that is managed in SAP DVS . The signature page adds one or more additional pages to the document. The signature page can be generated statically or dynamically.



What can Signature Page do?

Customer-specific design of the content and layout of the signature page is possible.

The signature page consists of a header area with a number of lines including the document's basic data and features. The second area is variable and contains a list of signatures and/or process data.



Who needs Signature Page?

Everyone who works in a validated environment or works with safety-related documents.

This module allows FDA compliant methods to be implemented as the default.

Release and review processes for a disclaimer of liability clause.

Additional information that goes beyond the scope of normal stamping.

The advantages

- + Validatable document control.
- + Required document data are automatically published along with the documents.
- + Design by means of SAP SmartForms.
- + Can be adapted as required in a customer-specific manner. Dynamic or static generation.
- + Required document data cannot be "forgotten" when distributing documents.
- + Creation of standard methods according to FDA compliant rules
- + A large number of user exits for extending product functionality.
- + Unicode-enabled product.



Product features

- Layout definition with SAP SmartForms.
- Adding the signature page to the original document.
- Configuration dialog for: Name of the SmartForm / function module for calculating the dates / insertion position / target format.
- Implementation in the DPF (Digital Process Factory®) technology from SEAL Systems.

Creation of dynamic and static signature pages facilitates secure document control.

Benefits

The signature page enforces publication of required document data along with the document when it is distributed. This is important for validatable document control, and makes sense in all cases where the quantity of information would make dynamic or static stamping of the original document illegible:

- when converting to a long-term format (static signature page)
- when viewing / displaying onscreen (dynamic signature page)
- when printing / generating electronic output (dynamic signature page)

Layout

The design (form and content) of the signature page is specified using an SAP form (SmartForms).

A sample form contained in the scope of delivery can be adapted to the project requirements.

Signature Page

Installation

Installation is performed by means of SAP transports (as needed, an RFC server will be set up). Base customization is performed with the push of a button by means of BC sets.

SAP System:

using SAP Basis as a transport, base configuration by means of BC sets.

External Server:

using SEAL Systems on the DPF server.

Scope of delivery

In addition to the software (SAP transport), the scope of delivery also includes detailed documentation (PDF) in German and English with practical examples.

System requirements

SAP versions ECC 6.0 and higher are supported with Enhancement Package.

For integration, either the SEAL Conversion Suite, SEAL Stamp & View or the SEAL Document Distribution Director module is required.
